The area around Nanzen-ji Temple in Kyoto, one of the most important Zen temples in the country, has long been known its delicious heated tofu served in a kelp broth. Junsei is housed in an early 19th century “shofu” style building, and in addition to its renowned tofu also serves shabu shabu and sukiyaki.
